**System of Assessment of Examination Works in English**



## Part 1

Maximum score for the entrance examination is 100 points.

Minimum possible entrance examination score is determined by the requirements separately set by KFU for each educational program.

The entrance examination is considered not passed if an applicant's result is lower than the minimum possible score of the entrance examination determined by the requirements of the KFU educational program.

Upon decision of the Examination Board, international applicants may use the results of the Malaysian University English Test (MUET). MUET is one of the main English language examinations in Malaysia accepted for admission to first degree programs in public universities and higher education institutions. MUET was brought in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). MUET results are recognized by the university as the results of entrance examinations conducted by the university independently. KFU establishes the correspondence of the level of the submitted certificate to the scores for internal entrance examination as follows:

MUET Level: <b>2.5</b> (A2 Level (Elementary Plus))	30 points
MUET Level: <b>3.0</b> (B1 Level (Pre-Intermediate))	50 points
MUET Level: <b>3.5</b> (B1+ Level (Intermediate))	60 points
MUET Level: <b>4.0</b> (B2 Level (Upper-Intermediate))	70 points
MUET Level: <b>4.5</b> (B2+ Level (Upper-Intermediate Plus))	80 points
MUET Level: <b>5.0</b> (C1 Level (Advanced))	90 points
MUET Level: <b>5+</b> (C1+ Level (Advanced Plus))	95 points

The entrance examination is of a competitive nature and includes lexical and grammatical test and one written assignment aimed at determining the level of proficiency in the system of basic knowledge and skills of a bachelor's program applicant.

Structure of the entrance examination: the examination has five blocks of tasks. Examination includes multiple-choice tasks and open-ended tasks, where applicants enter words themselves. **Maximum score for tasks 1-25 is 2 points, for tasks 26-35 - 3 points, for task 36 - 20 points.**

Applicants have 2 hours (120 minutes) to complete examination in English.

Answers for tasks can be a letter, word, part of sentence or an extended written statement.
